WHAT YOUR GROUP WILL LEARN

When your group arrives at the farm, they will be led to an outdoor presentation area. Rustic wooden benches will welcome them to enjoy a delightful presentation about butterflies. While the presentation focuses mainly on the lifecycle of the monarch butterfly, we also talk to the group about food sources, raising caterpillars, body parts of the butterfly, migration information, differences in moths and butterflies, and other interesting but not widely known facts.



Children and adults alike enjoy the presentation, and everyone learns something about butterflies.

The presentation includes some demonstrations using volunteers from the audience - an especially fun time for all ages - laughter abounds! Allow 20 minutes for the presentation.

FLIGHTHOUSE TOUR

After the presentation, your group will be taken to the flight house. This is the favorite part of the trip for everyone! The entire lifecycle of the butterfly is present in this environment. Host plants are loaded with newly-laid eggs, caterpillars in every

instar of development, and if the visitor is lucky, even Monarchs emerging from the chrysalis!

Members of the farm staff are present to explain, demonstrate, and educate your group. While we raise mostly Monarchs, we occasionally have other species in the flight house as well.

And, best of all, you will be surrounded by lovely butterflies nectaring on a multitude of plants and flowers. The butterflies are quite friendly, and visitors can expect one or two to land on them - always a delight! Each visitor is given a small sugar pad to use to coax the butterflies onto. The butterflies love to drink the sugar water from the pad, and this gives guests the opportunity to get an upclose look at the butterfly.



A bubbling fountain located in the house, along with benches to rest, provide our guests peace and tranquility beyond compare! Allow at least 25 minutes for this portion of the tour.

PICNIC AREA

Feel free to enjoy a picnic or snack in our picnic area after the tour. We have several umbrella covered picnic tables, or bring a blanket and do it the old-fashioned way! This is free time for your group - you are welcome to stay and relax on the farm!

PLANT NURSERY

Our farm specializes in both host & nectar plants for our winged friends. Milkweed available all season!! Plant Nursery open to the public M-Sat. 9 a.m.-3 p.m. (mid April-Oct.)

CATERPILLAR CASTLES

We offer a lifecycle kit for purchase known as a caterpillar castle. A caterpillar castle consists of one potted milkweed plant, with two monarch eggs laid on it, inside of a netted enclosure. You will receive everything you need to raise a butterfly in your very own home! The kit comes with a graphic of the lifecycle, along with complete instructions on how to raise your butterfly. In addition to your potted milkweed plant, you also receive a packet of perennial milkweed seeds. You will be amazed watching the entire process.
